Coordination with Catalan universities

For over 20 years the Catalan universities have conducted studies on the employability of its graduates. These studies were the basis for knowing:

- the transition of graduates into the labor world
- the degree of satisfaction with their education received at university

In 2000, the Agency and the 7 public universities agreed to begin the transversal evaluation of the labor market insertion of graduates.
